Whisky – Tasting notes

Overeem port cask matured Single Malt Hobart **\$26**

Colour – deep bright brass/gold

Nose – Chocolate ice cream, citrus, hay, vanilla rum, dried fruits
Barley sugar cinnamon & Christmas cake

Palate – chocolate, cinnamon, vanilla, hay, grass, stewed stone fruits

Finish – mildly bitter, spicy & warm. Subtle cocoa & bubble gum after taste

Battery Point Distillery Tawny Port cask matured Single Cask release – 46% alc **\$35**

BPD01 is a single 20L tawny cask from Seppeltsfield, which yielded only 34 bottles. It is rich and syrupy on the palate, with lots of heavy notes of plum and blackberries. A classic example of a tawny cask. It carries a distinct chewy and meaty characteristic,

Belgrove Rye whisky Kempton **\$24**

Nose – creamy & buttery, passionfruit & durian, grainy, fresh dough, sultanas, soft Christmas spices, jelly beans & icing for cakes.

Palate – grainy & malty, slightly peppery, green wood, milk chocolate & vanilla, spicy with a creamy texture, almonds, green walnuts, wet hay

Finish – warming, spicy, creamy butter texture, salivating, long & intense with grainy attitudes

Battery Point Distillery – Ruby Port Cask single Malt 53.8% alc **\$28**

Our 'Ruby' Single Malt Whisky has been created from Ruby Port Casks. It then sat in a muscatel barrel for six months to finish. Ruby Port / Muscatel Finish begins with the rich, oily texture, it then mellows down to the delicate flavours of the casks it was matured in. Notes of dates, raisins and plums transition into lighter notes of honey and stewed fruits, giving it a Christmas dessert styled finish. Complexity, maltiness, balance, harmony.

Callington Mill Sherry Fusion triple distilled Single Malt Oatlands \$17

Colour – Light Chestnut

Nose – Vibrant & engaging. Green apple, toffee & grapefruit

Palate – decadent & oily, wood smoke, Xmas Pudding & sultanas

Finish – Luxurious & warming, dark chocolate & golden syrup

Battery Point Distillery Single Malt whisky \$48
1st release – 51.9% alc

Nose – sweet & full, with definite overtones of sultana & apple.

Palate – rich, textural & full palate.

Finish – a long lasting finish.

McHenry single barrel Single Malt \$30
Port Arthur

Nose – citrus fruits, chocolate, almonds

Palate – citrus fruits, clean wood & youthful maltiness. The stickiness from the wood finish begins to unfold, chocolate coated almonds & burnt sugar & soft floral notes

Finish – toffee note to finish

Battery Point Distillery Triple cask matured \$26
Bourbon, Tawny & sherry casks – 46.7% alc

The outcome is an easy drinking, but complex whisky that sits anywhere from 45% to 50% ABV, depending on the batch. The nose is instantly hit with notes of vanilla and bourbon, before transforming into an aroma of confectionery with rose Persian fairy floss, orange peel and a touch of marzipan nuttiness.

Old Kempton Distillery “The Stables” single malt whisky **\$21**
Kempton

Colour – golden brown

Nose – beautiful fruit & nut notes with gentle malt notes a highlight

Palate – sweet & delicate upfront, building to a creamy toffee malt

Finish – warm satisfying glow, nicely balanced.

Lark Distillery “Symphony No. 1” Single Malt **\$22**
Hobart

Symphony No. 1 represents a composition of exceptional Tasmanian single malt whiskies. Head distiller Chris Thomson has expertly woven the complexity of American oak bourbon with the balance of sherry and heavier depth of port to form a creamy, oily melody of flavours; a malt whisky that’s full of life from start to finish.

Spring Bay Distillery Single Malt Whisky **\$24**
East Coast

Colour – Rose gold

Nose – sweet & complex aromas, suggest butterscotch & Christmas muscatels.

Palate – sweet caramel & plum pudding spices join a clean, bright alcoholic explosion, which spreads across the palate to settle in & glow with soft oaky tannins.

Finish – Hints of cherry cordial & some nutty undertones that clearly displays the quality of the spirit & the wood in developing harmony.



Whisky – Tasting notes

Battery Point Distillery port cask matured

This 'Port Cask Matured' Single Malt Whisky release consists of four carefully selected port casks; BPD 96,143,150 & 165, and a dash of heavily fortified port finishing cask to create this delicately crafted single malt whisky. Bottled at 46.4% abv, this release consists of 96 bottles using both Portuguese and Australian Tawny port casks.

Sweet confectionery jelly snakes fill the nose with a hint of butterscotch, brandy plums and warm Christmas pudding. The palate is highlighted by roasted chestnuts, blackcurrant jubes and light cream.

Complexity, maltiness, balance, harmony.

Lenna Private Label single malt whisky

This Single Malt Whisky was distilled by an infamous distillery near Bothwell in Tasmania's Central Highlands. It has been matured in a 100L Bourbon barrel, bottled at cask strength by Battery Point Distillery.

The nose brings unmistakable notes of candied pineapple, glazed fruits and canned nectarines. On the palate, pineapples, sandalwood and green bananas, come through, finishing with hints of custard and cream

House of Lenna Gin Battery Point

\$10

Nose – round and balanced juniper & citrus with fresh herb undertones.

Palate – quickly builds to a luscious sweet, oily & creamy palate, rich & complex. The right amount of juniper across the whole palate, presenting as a great classic dry gin.

Finish – very delicate & smooth. Lingers long, warm & clean.

House of Lenna Pink Gin Battery Point

\$10

Our blend no. 2 is a delicious pink gin, created with six botanicals distilled to create a fresh yet sweet gin. Fresh Tasmanian strawberries are then steeped in the gin to deliver a beautiful pink hue and mouth watering strawberry taste. The addition of tonka bean, vanilla, and orange give this exceptional gin a nostalgic feel that is reminiscent of eating candy on a warm summer's day.

House of Lenna Sloe Gin Battery Point

\$12

Distilled out of the House of Lenna Tasmanian copper pot still, Our blend no. 3 uses local Tasmanian Sloe berries from the Derwent Valley. The berries have been macerated for 4-6 months using 5 individually distilled botanicals to create a vibrant smooth Sloe Gin.

Notes of rich tart plum, citrus and vanilla bring a fruit-forward mouthfeel with lingering hints of juniper, creating this vibrant, rich in colour and easy-drinking Sloe Gin.



Gin – Tasting notes

Forty Spotted Gin **\$9**
Lark Distillery, Hobart
A traditional London dry gin

Nose – highly aromatic, fresh grated pepper on a floral bed of herbs & spices underpinning the delightful juniper notes.

Taste – rose petals & spicy juniper combined with a dry, clean & fresh spirit.

Finish – lemon peel dryness, warming to a slightly sweet lingering notes of herbs & spices.

McHenry London dry gin **\$9**
Port Arthur

An elegant smooth gin, like a magic carpet ride of the botanicals. Citrus peel is present & balanced by a small amount of star anise, corinader seeds, cardamon orris root, all beautifully balanced with juniper.

McHenry Sloe gin **\$13**
Port Arthur

Colour – ruby red

Nose – aromas of blackberry & raspberry

Palate – light & natural, with brambly dried berry flavours with hints of raspberry tart.

Finish – nicely balanced, mildly tannic & pleasantly long.

Gin – Tasting notes

McHenry Damson plum gin **\$13**
Port Arthur

Colour – ruby red

Nose – sweet, rich plum notes

Palate – begins with cherry, before a fermented rich plum takes over

Finish – lingering sweetness accompanied by orange with a hint of juniper.

Spring Bay gin **\$10**
Spring Bay, Orford

Nose – immediate sweet notes of juniper, liquorice & spice.

Palate – sweet juniper opening, then floral notes, bright citrus & a crescendo culminating in a big, warm, comforting afterglow of star anise & liquorice root.

Finish – a round smooth mouthfeel from this oily spirit gives way to a fine clean finish of liquorice & spice.

Poltergeist “unfiltered” gin **\$12**
Callington Mill, Oatlands

Nose – juniper & earthy notes & hints of forest floor.

Palate – elevated flavours of the spicier botanicals linger on the palate.

Finish – a strong flavor to finish

House of Lenna “Barrel Aged” Sloe Gin **\$14** **Battery Point**

Distilled out of the House of Lenna Tasmanian copper pot still, Our blend no. 3 uses local Tasmanian Sloe berries from the Derwent Valley. The berries have been macerated for 4-6 months using 5 individually distilled botanicals to create a vibrant smooth Sloe Gin. Notes of rich tart plum, citrus and vanilla brings a fruit forward mouthfeel with lingering hints of juniper, creating this vibrant, rich in colour and easy drinking Sloe Gin.

A portion of House of Lenna Sloe Gin has been put into a French Oak barrel and left to sit for 3 months to create our 'Barrel Aged' Sloe Gin. This barrel was previously used as a finishing cask for our Muscat aged Single Malt Whisky.

The same barrel was then 'wet filled' with Sloe Gin, adding a complex fortified wine influence, a little bit nuttiness with subtle notes of oak and whisky. Rich and long on the palate.

Vodka – Tasting notes

Hartsthorn Sheep Whey vodka **\$13** **Birchs Bay**

Nose – delicate brown sugar sweetness with a delightful floral undertone.

Palate – fresh pear & golden apple.

Finish – hints of wild spice, leather & mineral freshness to finish. Creamy sweet nose, velvet body with a smooth attitude to finish.

Hellfire Bluff Potato vodka **\$9** **Marion Bay**

Hellfire Bluff Vodka has a rich & buttery flavour profile, with a warm & spicy finish.
